

Tokyo International Workshop 2006 on Earthquake Disaster Mitigation for Safer Housing

1. Background and Objectives

Mitigation of earthquake disasters is one of the keenest issues common in earthquake prone areas in Asia. Four Japanese institutes listed in Item 2 launched a new research and development project entitled "Collaborative Research and Development Project for Disaster Mitigation on Network of Research Institutes in Earthquake Prone Areas in Asia" focusing on three essential research topics stated below in collaboration with research institutes in Indonesia, Nepal, Pakistan and Turkey.

Tokyo International Workshop 2006 is organized to discuss on the research and development project and to contribute to mitigate disasters through exchange of experiences and views and sharing best practices with participants from five countries connected by the video conference network and from all over the world through the web streaming services of the World Bank.

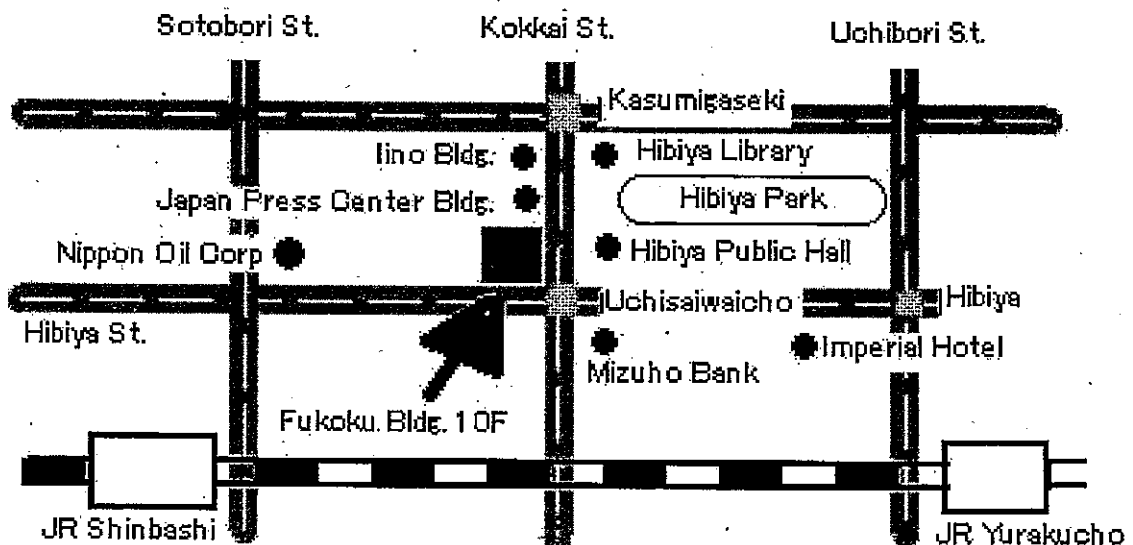

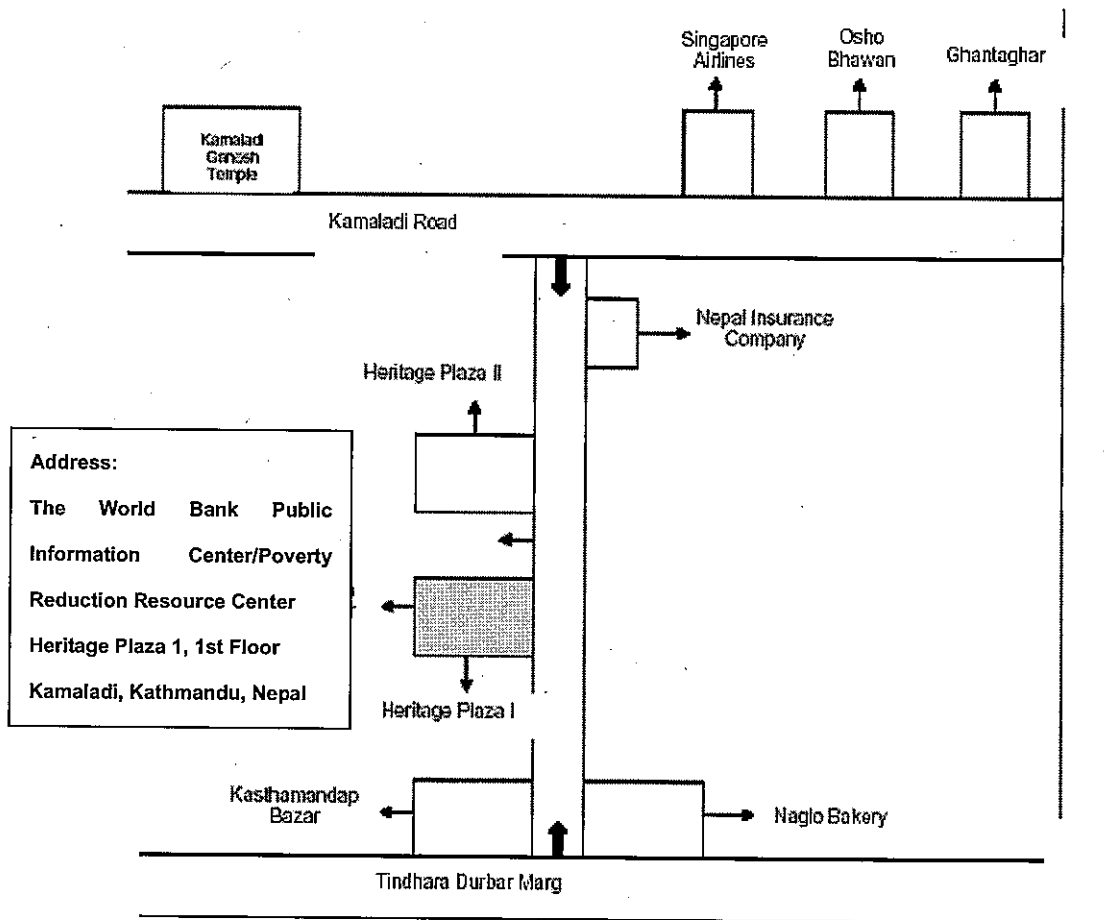

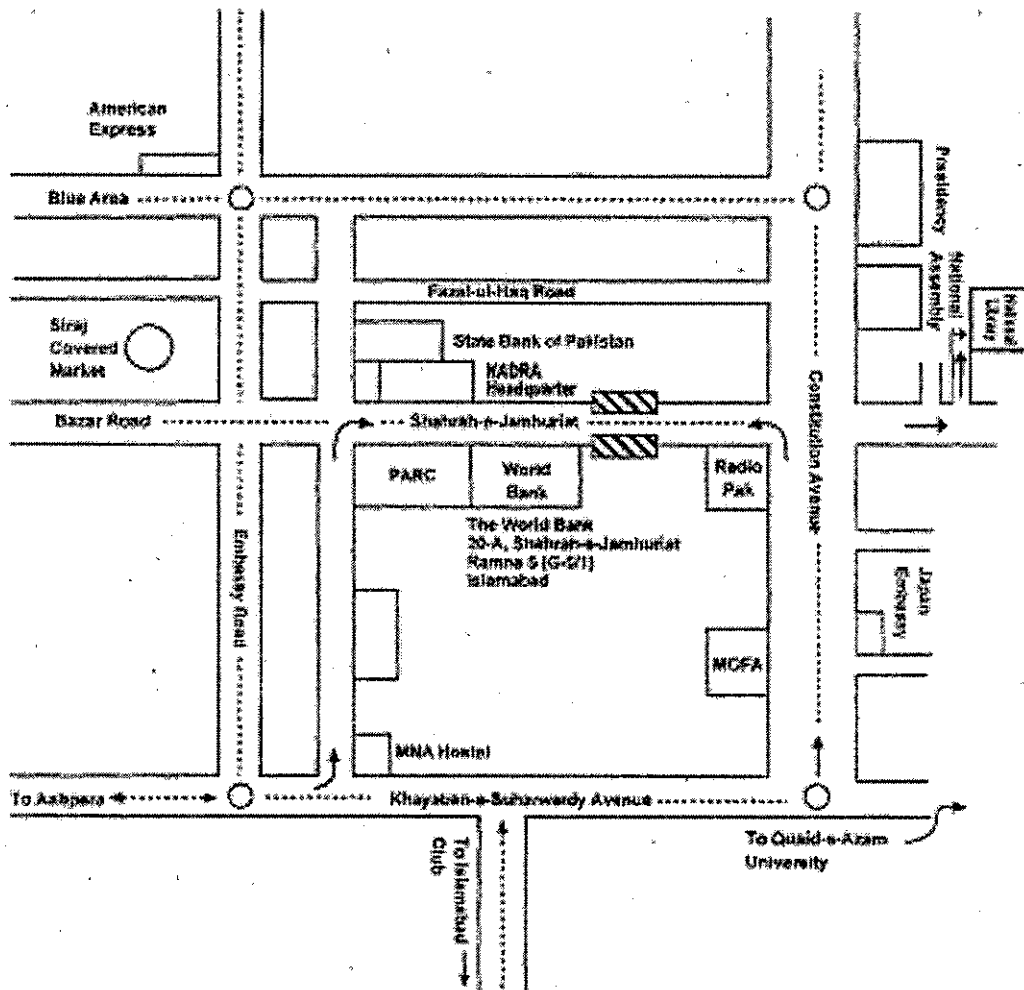
Location Map
