o “WOODRISE2017”, an international congress dealing with mid-to high-rise wooden buildings will be held this September (from the 12th) at Bordeaux, France.

o This congress is co-hosted by FCBA (France), FPInnovations (Canada), and Building Research Institute (Japan).

o Well-known architects, researchers, and practitioners concerned with wooden buildings from many countries including Europe and North America will take part in this congress. There will also be plenary sessions in the morning of Wednesday 13th to Thursday 14th September, workshops for each topics in the afternoon of 14th, a related event (Architecture Day) on the 12th, as well as Technical visits for wooden buildings etc. on the 15th.

o At the plenary sessions, there will be Japanese speakers such as architect Kengo Kuma, and professor of Keio University Toshiharu Ikaga, as well as experts from the local governments and private sectors. Our researchers will also be speaking about each of their research results at the “Fire Safety” and “Seismic Risk Prevention” Workshops. Moreover, research posters on “Fire Safety”, “Structures” as well as “Sound Proof” are now being prepared for exhibition.
