The latest issue of the CIB Encouraged Journal of Construction Economics and Building has just been published online.

Construction Economics and Building (formerly known as the Australasian Journal of Construction Economics and Building [AJCEB]) is a peer reviewed, open access publication for original research into all aspects of the economics and management of building and construction, quantity surveying and property management as well as construction and property education. It is free for authors, readers and libraries.

From this year the journal is adopting an article-based publication frequency model. Traditionally, there were four issues per year and each issue was published at a certain time. This meant, accepted papers had to wait in the queue for publication.

Now, there will be two issues a year, but papers will be published as they become available. This will help make accepted papers available/publishable quicker and to improve citations for authors.
