## Introduction:

The aim of the conference is to facilitate interdisciplinary integration and international cooperation among academicians, industry experts and researchers in project and construction management field to share their latest research findings, experiences and prospects. IPCMC2020 is expected to serve as a forum especially for the early stage researchers to discuss their research ideas, preliminary findings and develop academic networks. There will be two well-known keynote speakers: Prof. David Arditi (Illinois Institute of Technology, USA) and Prof. Miklós Hajdu (Budapest University of Technology and Economics, Hungary). IPCMC2020 conference is hosted by Istanbul Technical University. The first conference was hosted by Middle East Technical University in Turkey, in 2010. This conference has been subsequently delivered by Izmir Institute of Technology in 2012, Akdeniz University in 2014, Anadolu University in 2016, and Cyprus International University in 2018. The conference will be held in Istanbul for the first time. Istanbul, located between the Black Sea and Marmara Sea and with the Bosphorus Straight cutting through its center, has been the center of many civilizations throughout the ages as a result of its geographical location. Istanbul is the only city in the world standing upon 2 continents, Asia and Europe, with the perfect blend of cultures and heritage from both sides.
